



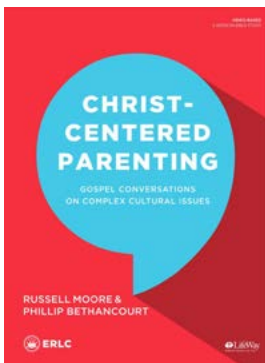
### In the Beginning – A Closer Look / Genesis 1–3
